Two dissemination events were organized gathering in total 73 people, both took place in Lörrach Germany. The events were organized in cooperation with the asylum centers and regional stakeholders from the region. The event aimed to disseminate good practices and learning approaches, that were utilized through the project. In particular, special focus was given into the new features of ACTION programme, especially the e-learning platform.

The event has created a great interest of the participants for the entire project. It has started by shortly presenting the project itself, aim, objectives and the main outcomes. Participants have been actively involved in the discussion and even at this stage some general questions arose, which were left for the final discussion. The core element of the event was dedicated to present the MOOC platform. It was highlighted the link between the IO1- Analysis of existing Training Programmes for Immigrants' employability and PR2- Design and delivery of Open Educational Resources Training Programm. In a nutshell was presented the findings of the Global report within the PR1.

Furthermore, the technical aspect was shortly presented following by introduction of the learning objectives of all modules. The main focus was the Module: Dive into Tourism created by the German partners. Tourism in Germany is a big sector with great opportunities for employment of the migrants. It was presented the knowledge transfer activities under PR3 and PR4 with both target groups: Vet teachers, administrative stuffs and migrants learners

Participants came with questions and their own views regarding the project's topic and the project outputs. As many migrants were presented their points were valuable. Besides the narrowed focus in the frame of the project activities, the discussion touched upon the Erasmus+ Program, challenges facing by the teachers and migrants learners in term of their upskilling and employment.

opportunity to hear about the project results. Positive reaction brought the European cooperation among the partners and sharing experience in term of the migrants' employability.
