Based on ARSIS vast experience in supporting people with refugee/migrant background was presented the barriers and the experiences in the labour and social integration of migrants.

From the HR Department was presented the profile of people with a migrant/refugee background seeking work in NGOs.

The speeches from the podium ended with the presentation of the difficulties and the opportunities for people with refugee backgrounds in job search.

Followed by a discussion with the audience attending the multiplier event.

- The presentation of the platform was well received and details of its operation were discussed.
- There was also great interest in how to support migrants in their job search.
